No Microwaves  
No Oil- or PCB-containing devices  
No Paints/Liquids of any Kind  
No Radioactive Materials  
(such as ION Scanners)  
No Refrigerants

## **Items accepted under special circumstances:**

- Batteries - All rechargeable dry- and wet-cell batteries still in devices. Alkaline batteries are not hazardous and may be disposed in the trash.
- Negatives - we WILL accept and securely destroy negatives for existing Federal Government customers that have data security concerns.
- Floppy Disks - we WILL accept and securely destroy floppy disks for existing Federal Government customers that have data security concerns.
