Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: When is Election Day in the City of Mount Rainier?

A: May 4, 2015

Q: What will be on the ballot?

A: -City Council Seat Ward 1

-City Council Seats Ward 2 (2 seats)

Q: Where and when do I vote?

A: May 4, 2015 at Mount Rainier City Hall 7am-8pm

Q: How do I become a candidate?

A: Obtain a petition at City Hall or www.mountrainiermd.org, follow all instructions and return it April 6th between 6PM and 8PM

Q: When can I meet the candidates?

A: Candidate Forums: 4/18/2015 at City Hall 6pm-8pm and 4/25/2015 at Mount Rainier Nature Center 6pm to 8pm

Q: How can I get registered to vote?

A: You can register online here: <https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/OnlineVoterRegistration/InstructionsStep1>



Q: Do I have to submit a separate registration to vote in the City Election?

A: No, if you are already a registered voter in the state of Maryland, you do not have to submit a separate registration.

Q: Is there early voting for the Mount Rainier City Election?

A: No. If you will be out of town or unable to vote on election day May 4, 2015, please request an absentee ballot from City Hall OR the Mount Rainier Board of Elections: mtrainierboardofelections@gmail.com

Q: How do I get an absentee ballot?

A: Absentee ballots can be picked up from City Hall starting on April 17th, or absentee voters can request that the ballot be mailed to them up to 6 days prior to election day (May 4, 2015)

Q: When are Absentee ballots due?

A: Absentee ballots must be received at the post office no later than May 4, 2015.

Q: How do I know what Ward I belong to?




Q: Is there a ride service for getting to the polls?

A: Please contact Call-A-Bus for more information here: <http://www.mountrainiermd.org/residents/transportation/> or call 301-985-6586 to schedule a ride on May 4, 2015 (it is best to call and schedule an appointment for transportation services). For those persons physically impaired (i.e., mobility issues) the transportation is available 9:00am until 1:00pm and from 3:00pm until polls close at 8:00pm.
