



**FRIDAY: Creating for Peace**


Today, come up with at least one creative idea to resolve a conflict, either in your personal life or your family circle or among friends.



### **What is the Parade Route?**


The Parade will begin at 10:00 am at 22nd and Varnum Street. The parade ends at 12:00 pm at the Brentwood Fire Station.


