**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROJECT TO**

**Provide afterschool tutoring and enrichment to children in the Queens Manor Apartments, and information and referral and family literacy programs to their families through the HIP Kids and Families Program. This resolution supports the application of HIP Services Inc., a nonprofit organization certified by the Secretary of State of Maryland, to the State of Maryland to obtain Community Investment Tax Credits for the Hippest Kids project. HIP Services will sell these credits to participating individuals and corporations to support the program.**

**WHEREAS, HIP Services, Inc., a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and**

**WHEREAS, HIP Services, Inc. has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for approval of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project, under the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and**
