**A Resolution appointing a citizen volunteer to the City of Mount Rainier Youth and Recreation Committee**


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have the authority to create committees and appoint citizens to those committees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City appointed a Youth and Recreation Committee via Resolution 4-2006; and


**WHEREAS**, the Committee has been reactivated and the council desires to appoint a resident who has expressed interest in participating on the committee.






