The officer then reviewed surveillance footage at a nearby business, which showed the suspect selling the stolen merchandise to two unidentified individuals in a parking lot shortly after the theft. Payment was made once in cash and once electronically. The suspect was taken into custody, searched, and found in possession of a small amount of cash. The total value of the stolen merchandise, including tax, was \$56.23. After being advised of Miranda rights, the suspect admitted to stealing and reselling the items. The suspect was issued a trespass notice and a criminal citation for theft under \$100, then released after signing the required documents.
