ORDINANCE NO. 13-2021

Introduced by Mayor Celina Benitez

Providing a Temporary Amnesty
for Certain Parking Violations

WHEREAS, the Mount Rainier Code in Chapter 9, "Parking Meters", establishes a parking meter program and provides that violations of Chapter 9 are municipal infractions subject to the fines and penalties set forth in the City's Schedule of Fees, as adopted from time to time by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted a fee schedule by Ordinance 02-2020, dated March 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the current adverse economic conditions prevailing for many City residents caused at least in part by the COVID-19 pandemic, the City Council believes the public interest will be best served by granting an amnesty for late fees and penalties accrued in connection with parking citations outstanding on the effective date of this ordinance, provided that the original fines are paid on or before April 30, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER, MARYLAND, that:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provisions in the City of Mount Rainier Fee Schedule to the contrary, all late fees and penalties accrued in connection with parking citations outstanding on the effective date of this Ordinance are waived, provided that the original fines are paid on or before April 30, 2022.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.


