**A RESOLUTION TO HONOR
MAYOR MALINDA G. MILES
FOR HER DISTINGUISHED SERVICE
TO THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER**

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles has served the Citizens of Mount Rainier with great skill and distinction;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles has served as the City of Mount Rainier's Mayor for 16 years and is the longest serving Mayor in the City's history;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles has served as a leader, mentor, and friend to many of her elected colleagues, past and present, doing her part to make democracy function better in Mount Rainier;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles has championed the arts, environmental initiatives, and revitalization;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles has acquired hundreds of thousands of grant dollars and persuaded groups and businesses to aid the City of Mount Rainier and its citizens;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles over the years has advocated for the purchase of real estate to improve the City's portfolio of assets;

WHEREAS Malinda Miles has been involved in several key real estate transactions, including:

- the purchase of 3249 Rhode Island Avenue (now home to the Mount Rainier Police Department and Code Compliance),
- purchase of 3405 Rhode Island Avenue (Potts Hall),
- purchase and redevelopment of 3411 Perry Street (a much needed municipal parking lot), and
- the profitable sale of 3200 Rhode Island Avenue;

WHEREAS, Malinda Miles negotiated the purchase of 3503 and 3505 Perry Street, properties the City has long sought to acquire;


Therefore, to honor her contributions to the City, be it resolved that 3505 Perry Street will henceforth be known as the “Malinda Miles Municipal Center”


