A resolution declaring that City-owned personal property consisting of three motor vehicles not needed by the City of Mount Rainier for public use; and, providing for the City to dispose of the vehicles at public auction or scrap.

WHEREAS, the City owns the following motor vehicles:

1993 Ford Crown Victoria 4 door sedan vehicle identification 2FACP71WXPX169903 known as vehicle 78; and

1995 Ford Crown Victoria 4 door sedan vehicle identification 2FALP71W8SX171531, known as vehicle 89; and

1997 Ford Crown Victoria 4 door sedan vehicle identification 2FALP71W8VX134273, known as vehicle 91; and


WHEREAS, these vehicles are beyond repair and thus have no operational value to the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Mount Rainier, Maryland, that the vehicles are not needed by the City for public use, are declared surplus to be disposed of by public auction through Colonial Auto Auction Service of Upper Marlboro, Maryland, by scrap, or whichever is the best means, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City shall give not less than 20 days public notice that the vehicles have been declared surplus and the means of giving public notice will include posting notices at City Hall, One Municipal Place and at the Police Department 3249 Rhode Island Avenue.




