

RECENT EXECUTIVE ORDERS FROM GOVERNOR HOGAN

(i) Meetings of Stockholders: Publicly traded companies are authorized to postpone shareholder meetings and to conduct such meetings on a virtual basis.

(ii) Use of Face Coverings:

-Face coverings, including scarves, must be worn by people of all ages while using public transportation and by people ages 9 and up while patronizing grocery stores and other retail locations. (Please don't recommend the use of medical masks.)

- Parents must use best efforts to have children ages 2 to 9 wear face coverings in grocery stores and other retail locations.

- Food establishments and other retail locations must assure physical distance in customer queues, sanitize carts, and maintain properly stocked rest rooms.

- The secretary of health may impose additional requirements to ensure public health and safety.

- Enforcement is the responsibility of both state and local law-enforcement agencies.

(iii) Preserving Supplies of Critical Drugs: Pharmacists may fill prescriptions for certain drugs, including hydroxychloroquine, to individuals for the purpose of preventing or treating COVID-19.

Pharmacists may only provide a 14-day supply of such drugs to individuals who have been diagnosed with and are being treated for COVID-19. Patients being treated for other conditions may still have access to these drugs in their customary doses.
