### **Resolution 10-2020: A Resolution Concerning COVID-19 Hazard Pay for Eligible Employees of the City of Mount Rainier**

#### **Introduced By: Mayor & City Council**

**WHEREAS**, the global pandemic Coronavirus (“COVID-19”) continues to pose an imminent risk to the health, safety and welfare of City of Mount Rainier residents; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency declarations issued at the federal, State and County level remain in effect; and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 continues to present economic and personnel challenges for the City ; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has recommended that the Salary Plan be amended to reflect the addition of COVID-19 Hazard Pay for employees of the Public Works and Police Department who have, in the judgment of the City Manager, been required by their job duties to encounter elevated risk of infection from the virus that causes COVID-19; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor & City Council of the City of Mount Rainier that eligible Police employees who worked during the period from March 1, 2020 through August 30, 2020 (27 Weeks) will be entitled to receive COVID-19 hazard Pay in the amount of \$350 a week up to a total amount of \$9,450.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor & City Council of the City of Mount Rainier that eligible Public Works employees who worked during the period from March 1, 2020 through August 16, 2020 (25 Weeks) will be entitled to receive COVID-19 Hazard Pay in the amount of \$250 a week up to a total amount of \$6,250.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect on the day it is adopted and COVID-19 Hazard Pay shall be provided to eligible employees starting the next pay period.
