**RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT A PROJECT TO CREATE MORE AFFORDABLE ACCESSIBILITY TO HIGH-QUALITY ARTS EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR LOW-TO-MODERATE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS IN THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER.**

**WHEREAS**, Club Joe’s is a Maryland state licensed weekday after school program for school-aged youth 5-13 years old where students learn team building, critical-thinking and problem-solving skills, while also sharpening their fine motor and cognitive skills.

**WHEREAS**, World Arts Focus d.b.a. Joe’s Movement Emporium, a nonprofit organization, proposes to support the after school program mentioned above (the “Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, World Arts Focus d.b.a. Joe’s Movement Emporium has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for funding of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project, under the Department’s Community Investment Tax Credit Program: and
