**CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER, MARYLAND
RESOLUTION 13-2017**

A resolution declaring that City-owned personal property consisting of one trailer is not needed by the City of Mount Rainier for public use; and, providing for the City to dispose of the vehicles at public auction, sale or scrap as determined by the Director of Public Works.

WHEREAS, the City owns one large trailer model year and number unknown, which is at least fifteen years old.

WHEREAS, this trailer is beyond repair and has been stripped of all markings and equipment, and thus has no operational value to the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of Mount Rainier, Maryland, that the trailer is not needed by the City for public use, is declared surplus, and shall be disposed of by public auction, sale or scrap, or whichever is the best means as determined by the Director of Public Works; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City shall give not less than 20 days public notice that the trailer has been declared surplus and the means of giving public notice shall include posting notices at City Hall, One Municipal Place Mount Rainier, Maryland 20712; and at the Mount Rainier Police Department located at 3249 Rhode Island Avenue Mount Rainier, Maryland 20712.




