**ORDINANCE NO. 06-2017**

**Authorizing a Movement of Funds in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget between Line Items**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mount Rainier Budget for Fiscal Year 2018 was adopted by Ordinance No. 5-2017, in June 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been deemed necessary to transfer funds between line items to meet current demand for goods and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds being moved between line items is not dependent upon City reserves.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER, MARYLAND, THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**

Amount: \$22,000

FROM: Line Item 3010: Regular Pay, City Hall  
TO: Line Item 3010: Regular Pay, Code Enforcement  
Amount: \$10,122

FROM: Line Item 3010: Regular Pay, City Hall  
TO: Line Item 3010: Regular Pay, Economic Development  
Amount: \$5,000

**2. POLICE DEPARTMENT**

FROM: Public Safety Reserve Fund (GL#1008-2)  
Amount: \$46,000  
TO: Vendors for Police Cameras and Police Computers




