ORDINANCE NO. 08-2017, BUDGET AMENDMENT #2

Authorizing a Movement of Funds in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget between Line Items

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier Budget for Fiscal Year 2018 was adopted by Ordinance No. 5-2017, in June 2017; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary to transfer funds between line items to meet current demand for goods and services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER, MARYLAND, THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. PUBLIC WORKS

FROM: Line Item 4500: Contingency Fund

AMOUNT: \$25,000

TO: Line Item 6487: Vehicle Purchase / CIP, Public Works

Amount: \$25,000

PUBLIC WORKS

FROM: Line Item 9010 Transfer from Reserves

AMOUNT: \$60,000

TO: Line Item 6487: Vehicle Purchase / CIP, Public Works

Amount: \$60,000

PUBLIC WORKS

FROM: Line Item 3010: City Hall Regular Pay

AMOUNT: \$63,000

TO: Line Item 6487: Vehicle Purchase / CIP, Public Works

Amount: \$63,000

Total: \$148,000

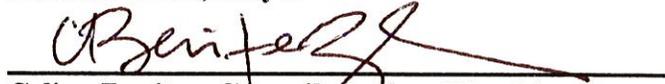

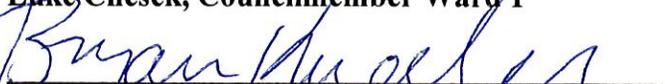
