Resolution approving a project by World Arts Focus, d.b.a. Joe's Movement Emporium, to train low-income teens in the technical theater and digital media trades for the purpose of qualifying the project for State of Maryland tax credits under the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

WHEREAS, World Arts Focus, d.b.a. Joe's Movement Emporium, a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake a project, known as the Theater Tech Program, to train low-income teens in the technical theater and digital media trades (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Theater Tech Program teaches life and work skills, college exploration, financial literacy, and provides paid internships and job placement, possibly leading to a career in entertainment, hospitality or the media arts; and



Joe's Movement Emporium has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development ("DHCD") of the State of Maryland for approval of the Project and for an allocation of tax credits for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project, under the DHCD's Community Investment Tax Credit Program: and


