**A Resolution Declaring the City of Mount Rainier's Intent
to Take a Leadership Role in Reducing Transportation Petroleum Consumption
in and by the City of Mount Rainier, by Partnering with the
Maryland Energy Administration and Enrolling as a Smart Energy Community.**

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier has received a FY 15 Maryland Smart Energy Communities (MSEC) award to purchase a GEM vehicle and before any costs are incurred for the purchase of the GEM vehicle, the City of Mount Rainier desires to adopt the MSEC Petroleum Reduction Policy; and

WHEREAS, by adhering to the Maryland Energy Administration's Smart Energy Communities Program, the City of Mount Rainier has committed to being a socially responsible leader by reducing its local impact by better managing its transportation petroleum consumption; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier recognizes that by smartly investing in alternative transportation uses, it can have significant monetary savings and create environmental benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER, that the City of Mount Rainier adopts the following goals and initiatives:

SECTION 1: Purpose. The purpose of this policy is:

- To become a Maryland Energy Administration Smart Energy Community by enrolling within the program and following the instructions provided by the State of Maryland.
- To reduce on-road vehicle petroleum consumption by Mount Rainier's fleet vehicles by 20% within five years of the established baseline year.
- To report petroleum consumption and reduction progress annually to the Maryland Energy Administration in order to assure that the City of Mount Rainier accomplishes said goals in a timely fashion.

Applicability.


This policy applies to all City Departments with the exception of any exclusions outlined in the definitions above.

SECTION 5: Effective Date.

This Resolution and the City of Mount Rainier's Transportation Petroleum Reduction Policy shall be effective immediately.




