**WHEREAS, HIP Services, Inc., a non-profit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and**




**WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier approves the Project.**


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Mount Rainier hereby expresses approval of the Project, as described above.
