A Resolution of the City of Mount Rainier approving the application and a receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Project(s) (the "Project") further described in the Community Legacy Application ("The Application"), to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located within a priority founding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Community Legacy Project and the Project Financing by the City of Mount Rainier and, where appropriate, by the chief executive official of the local subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Mount Rainier hereby endorses the Project and hereby approves the request for financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan up to the amount of \$_____.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution; and






