A Resolution Creating a Volunteer Citizen Green Team to ensure that the City's Sustainability Plans are executed

WHEREAS, the City intends to become certified under the Sustainable Maryland Certified program; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted an Environmental Sustainability Plan and Assessment, created a Community Action Plan, and adopted an ordinance that established the city's green initiatives.


