A Resolution establishing a Mount Rainier Community Services Task Force

WHEREAS, there are from time to time people in our city in need because of damage from a storm, fire, flood or other disaster; and

WHEREAS, there are people in our city who are in need because of the economic problems besetting our county; and

WHEREAS, there are people in our city who are in need because of developments in their personal lives;

WHEREAS, there are many residents in our city who would like to help their neighbors in times of need; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous Federal, State, County and non-governmental organizations that will support residents in time of need; and

WHEREAS there is need to match those Mount Rainier residents in need with those people and organizations that offer services to people in need.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


1. The Mayor and Council hereby establish a City of Mount Rainier Community Services Task Force;
2. The Task Force will report back to the Council by the September 2013 Council work session
3. Six residents will be appointed to the task force;
4. There will be a Council liaison who will call the first meeting and staff liaison (who does not necessarily have to go to the Task Force meetings);
5. The Community Services Task Force is charged with:
 - a. The responsibility of identifying organizations that have resources and programs for people in need;
 - b. The responsibility of working with the City staff in developing a procedure


