**A Resolution approving the application and receipt of financing for a[Community Legacy Project(s)] (the "Project") further described in the Community Legacy Application ("The Application"), to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.**

**WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier** recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in the Gateway Arts District; and,

**WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and**

**WHEREAS, the Project is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and**

**WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Community Legacy Project and the Project Financing by the City of Mount Rainier and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City of Mount Rainier hereby endorses the Project in the; and, HEREBY approves the request for financial assistance in the form of a grant or loan, up to the amount of \$ 50,000 ; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and Council of the City of Mount Rainier, are hereby requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating their approval thereof; and,**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution; and,**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, copies of this Resolution are sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.**

Should the Council retire to executive or closed session, the chair will announce the reasons and a report will be issued at a future meeting disclosing the reasons for such session.*


