**RESOLUTION 6-2009**

Introduced By: Mayor Miles, & Council members

**A Resolution to approve projects to remove blighted and outdated corrugated grates located in the front of businesses in the city's downtown, expand the existing Intermodal Pedestrian Project, and enhance the Green Home Pilot Project that contributes to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Community Legacy Areas while educating homeowners about cost-saving green technologies that will improve their respective properties.**

**Project No. 1 entitled the Commercial Business District Façade Improvement Program will support and compliment the façade improvement program for businesses in the commercial district that has commitment from the City of Mount Rainier and the Mount Rainier Business Association for the Fiscal Year 2010; Project No. 2 is an Expansion of the Intermodal Pedestrian Project currently funded through the Federal Transit Administration, the goal of which is to decrease vehicular traffic and provide incentives to use public transportation via parking venues, bicycle racks, etc., and Project No. 3 enhances the Green Home Pilot Project funded through the Washington Area Community Investment Fund and Community Legacy to improve residential properties through "green" initiatives.**

**WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier, a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and**

**WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainer [the non-profit organization] has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for approval of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the Project, under the Department's Community Legacy Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the City of Mount Rainier the governing body or its authorized designee] approves the Project,**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Mount Rainier [governing body or its authorized designee] hereby expresses approval of the Project, as described above.

**ADOPTED AND APPROVED** by the City of Mount Rainier Council this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009.




