AND APPLYING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF RHODE ISLAND AVENUE AND 34<sup>TH</sup>  
STREET BY APPLICATION AND TO RECEIVE MAIN STREET MARYLAND  
DESIGNATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mount Rainier recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of this community in Mount Rainier; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mount Rainier proposes to designate the areas of Rhode Island Avenue and 34<sup>th</sup> Street in Mount Rainier; as outlined on the attached map as a Main Street Area which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7b-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to local zoning code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the City of Mount Rainier hereby endorses the designation of the Area, Hereby approves the request in the form of application; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the chief elected official be and is hereby requested to endorse the Resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of these resolutions; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, copies of this resolution be sent to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration by the Main Street Maryland Program.


