A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROJECT TO

Launch local movement-based and recreational activities that will help residents to curb the rate of obesity and promote better physical well-being. Activities will take place in the offices and studios of the organization's community performing arts center (dba: Joe's Movement Emporium). The schedule of programs will involve stretching and toning activities, yoga, tai chi, dance fitness, and other dance and aerobic classes. Programs will serve a range of ages, from children and youth to senior citizens, and will be supervised by a licensed nurse practitioner.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of Mount Rainier, Maryland, as follows:

WHEREAS, World Arts Focus, Inc., a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the project described above (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, World Arts Focus, Inc., has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for approval of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the Project, under the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and


