**An Ordinance Revising the ~~City of Mount Rainier Code of Ordinances~~,
Chapter 11 - Refuse Collection, to Amending the Day for Recycling, Bulk Trash,
and Yard Waste Collection Services When the Normal Schedule
Recycling Collection Day Falls on a Holiday or on a
Day that Inclement Weather Prohibits Collection.**

WHEREAS, the City elects to provide recycling collection services on Friday of each week; and

WHEREAS, ~~it has been determined that~~ when the regular recycling collection service day falls on a holiday, the collection service is currently deferred until the following Friday which causes some difficulty concern for residents who have an overflow of recycled able materials to be collected each weekly basis; and

WHEREAS, ~~in accordance with the Council wishes to amend the Mount Rainier Code, Chapter 11, Section 11-104, General Provisions, and Section 11-112, Recycling, to provide that recyclable states that if the city collection day for regular trash or [bio-degradable yard waste] falls on a holiday, this materials will be picked up on the next regular work day following the a holiday or inclement weather prohibiting collection, rather than on the next scheduled recyclables collection day; and~~

WHEREAS, in order to lessen the work load of the City Public Works Department on the day following a holiday or inclement weather, the Council is amending Mount Rainier Code, Chapter 11, Section 11-104, General Provisions, to provide that collection of bulk trash and yard waste will be delayed until the next scheduled collection day following the holiday or inclement weather.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNT RAINIER THIS _____ day of _____, 2014 that the Mount Rainier Code is amended following revisions will be made to Chapter 11, as follows:

Chapter 11 – Refuse Collection

Section 11-104. General Provisions.

~~[A. If the City collection day for regular trash or biodegradable yard waste falls on a holiday, this material will be picked up the next regular work day following the holiday. If the City collection day for recyclables falls on a holiday, this material will be picked up [on the next scheduled recyclables collection day] THE NEXT REGULAR WORK DAY FOLLOWING THE HOLIDAY AND THE COLLECTION DAY FOR BULK TRASH AND BIO-DEGRADABLE YARD WASTE WILL BE THE NEXT SCHEDULED BIO-DEGRADABLE YARD WASTE AND BULK TRASH COLLECTION DAYS. If the City collection day for bulk trash falls on a holiday, appointments will be made to pick up bulk trash on the next regular work day following the holiday. IF THE CITY COLLECTION DAY FOR [RECYCLABLES] BIO-DEGRADABLE YARD WASTE FALLS ON A HOLIDAY, THIS MATERIAL WILL BE PICKED UP ON THE NEXT SCHEDULED [RECYCLABLES] BIO-DEGRADABLE YARD WASTE COLLECTION DAY. THE City shall at least monthly provide a collection schedule (e.g., via the newsletter, Web site, cable television channel, etc.)]~~

- A. If the City collection day for regular trash OR RECYCLABLES ~~[or biodegradable yard waste]~~ falls on a holiday OR IF INCLEMENT WEATHER PROHIBITS COLLECTION, THEN this material will be picked up the next regular work day following the holiday OR INCLEMENT WEATHER. If the City collection day for bulk trash OR YARD WASTE falls on a holiday OR IF INCLEMENT WEATHER PROHIBITS COLLECTION, THEN ~~[appointments will be made to pick up bulk trash on the next regular work day following the holiday]~~ THIS MATERIAL WILL BE PICKED UP ON THE NEXT SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY FOR BULK TRASH OR YARD WASTE. ~~[If the City collection day for recyclables falls on a holiday, this material will be picked up on the next scheduled recyclables collection day.]~~ The City shall at least monthly provide a collection schedule (e.g., via the newsletter, Web site, cable television channel, etc.).


Section 11-112. Recycling.


- A. Recyclables will be collected from single family residential and multi-family residential dwellings every Friday. Recyclables must be set out for pick up no sooner than 7:00 p.m. the day before the scheduled collection day and no later than 7:00 a.m. the day of the scheduled pick-up. If a collection day falls on a holiday or if the weather is such to prohibit collection, the next recyclable collection will be the next ~~[Friday]~~ REGULAR WORK DAY FOLLOWING THE HOLIDAY OR INCLEMENT WEATHER PROHIBITING COLLECTION.

This Ordinance shall be effective on _____ 2014.


