Mount Rainier, MD – According to the National Weather Service, Tropical Storm Isaias is expected to impact much of the Eastern Seaboard this week. As of today, August 3, a Tropical Storm Watch is in effect. On Tuesday, tropical storm conditions are possible, with the highest immediate impacts coming from damaging wind gusts. In addition, a Coastal Flood Watch and a Flash Flood Watch are also in effect beginning on Tuesday and lasting through Friday.

Residents with a history of flooding, specifically located on Perry Street, may wish to take measures to safeguard against potential losses associated with flooding. The Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) has a number of services available to assist local homeowners with information about how to reduce the likelihood of flood losses.
