Mr. Harrington previously served as Mayor of Bladensburg and the Prince George's County Council. A longtime advocate for healthy communities, he was also instrumental in introducing the Wellness Opportunity Zone in Prince George's County in addition to serving as a Senior Policy Advisor for Common Health Action.
